Carl E. DuBois

Class of 1972

Mr. DuBois graduated from Minisink Valley in 1972 where he earned two varsity letters in baseball. He currently serves as the elected Sheriff of Orange County. Previously, he was a police officer with the Middletown Police Department retiring after 22 years of service at the rank of lieutenant. He has also served as the Otisville Village Justice and the Mount Hope Town Justice. He earned a Bachelor's Degree from Mercy College and is a graduate of the FBI National Academy. His two sons graduated from Minisink Valley as well.

Joseph Sottolano

Class of 1986

Mr. Sottolano graduated from Minisink Valley in 1986 where he earned varsity letters in football and baseball. He was the Times-Herald Record's "Baseball Player of the Year" in 1986. He currently serves as Head Baseball Coach at the United States Military Academy. In his six seasons at West Point, his teams have won three Patriot League titles and made three appearances in the NCAA Division I Baseball Tournament. He has been voted Patriot League Coach of the Year twice and was a finalist for National Coach of the Year in 2004. He holds both a Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree from Ithaca College. As a player at Ithaca, he was named "Most Outstanding Player" of the 1988 NCAA Division III College World Series and the team was crowned national champions.
